Exemption of Fees: Scholarship that the student does not pay fees himself/herself.

Full Scholarship: Scholarship that covers fees, accomodation and monthly allowance.

Graduate Student: A Student who completed the curricula and successfuly defended his/her final course project, even if he/she does not attend the graduation ceremony.

New Intake: Any student who enters and is enrolled at Universidade

Reduced Scholarship: Scholarship that covers fees and monthly allowance.

Registered Student: Any student who have registered and attending at least one subject during a given semester.

Scholarship Holder: Student awarded any type of Scholarship.

UNESCO Classification: Concepts, definitions and classifications that provide a framework for the compilation and presentation of International Education Statistics and Indicators.








Graphic 1-Numbers of Candidates and Vacancies, 2006 -2015




Graphic 2-Evolution of Numbers of Enrolled Students, 2005-2015




Graphic 3-Numbers of Enrolled Students by Faculty/ School




Graphic 4-Numbers of Enrolled Students and New Intake Students by Faculty/ School




Graphic 5-Numbers of Enrolled Students by Academic Degree and Gender



Graphic 6-Numbers of Graduate Students by Faculty/ School




Graphic 7- Numbers of Students with Scholarship by Types of Scholarship and Fees




Graphic 8-Numbers of Full-Time Teaching Staff by Nationality and Gender

Graphic 9- Numbers of Teaching Staff by Contractual Regime and Academic Degree


